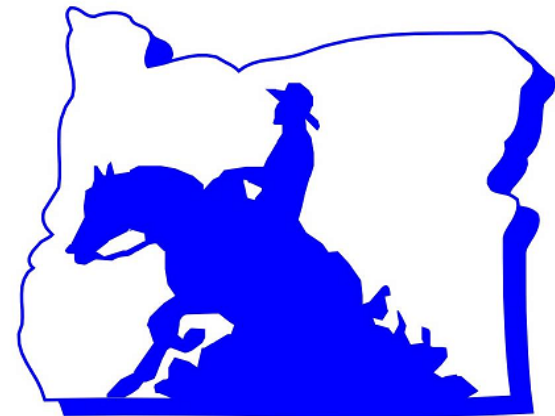

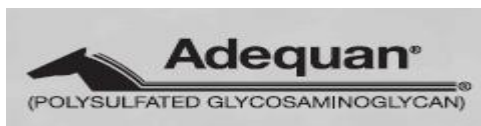

\$15 fee for initial late entry (doesn't apply to adds/scratches)

Show Guidelines:

- **Scratches:** Anyone scratching a class will not be charged for that class if the horse is scratched IN THE OFFICE before the draw is posted.
- **Adds:** Classes may be added as long as the class has not started. If the draw has been posted, the OFFICE will determine where the add goes in the draw.
- **Returned checks:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged \$25.00. ▫
- This is an NRHA approved show and current NRHA rules shall prevail in all matters including, but not limited to: eligibility of horse and rider, breaking of ties, use of illegal equipment, abuse or mistreatment of any horse, unsportsmanlike conduct, and failure to pay.
- Membership in ORHA is **not** required to participate at the show; however it is required to earn ORHA points and/or to qualify for the NRHA Western Region Affiliate Finals. NRHA membership is required for all NRHA classes.

To Qualify for ORHA Year End Awards

- The **owner and exhibitor of the horse must be a member** of ORHA prior to the first show in which you want points to be calculated for year-end awards. **YOU MUST SHOW AT LEAST 4 TIMES IN A CLASS TO QUALIFY FOR A YEAR END AWARD.**
- The horse must be nominated with ORHA prior to the first show in which you want points to be calculated towards year end awards. There is a \$15 nomination fee per horse to nominate for the year.
- 2009 ORHA Membership/Nomination forms will be available at the show.

New for 2009

- ✓ ORHA club classes can now be **Jackpotted!** – For an additional \$10 fee per club class, you will be able to Jackpot any ORHA club class in 2009. 100% of all jackpot fees go into the pot!
- ✓ ORHA club class **circuit awards** were introduced at the April 11-12 show. For each ORHA club class, the highest cumulative score from the Saturday and Sunday runs will receive a circuit club class award. This will be in place of all ORHA club class day awards except for the Ladies and Gents classes which only run on Saturday.
- ✓ NRHA Rookie 1 & Rookie 2 classes are available. Rookie Level 2 is a new division in 2009, check out the NRHA Class Guidelines section of this premium for more information.
- ✓ The NRHA Novice Horse Open and Non Pro classes and new earnings limits for horses, please check out the NRHA Class Guidelines section of this premium for more information.

ORHA Club Classes Approved for Year End Awards

HACKAMORE/SNAFFLE: Restricted to horses 5 years of age and younger. Must show in an NRHA approved snaffle bit or hackamore.

OPEN: Any rider may show any horse in this class. Points based on the horse.

NON-PRO: Open to any rider holding a current NRHA Non-Pro card, Non-Pro/Amateur card OR Youth card from other breed organizations. A Non-Pro is defined by NRHA as a person who has not directly or indirectly shown, trained, given lessons, or assisted in the training of a horse ridden astride for remuneration-this does not include prize money. Payment of entry fees and/or expenses by anyone other than the Non-Pro, his or her immediate family or his or her corporation is considered remuneration. A Non-Pro horse must be owned by the Non-Pro or his immediate family. See NRHA rulebook for reference. Points based on each horse/rider combination.

PRIME TIME NON-PRO: Open to Non Pro riders 50yrs and older as of 1/1/09. Points based on each horse/rider combination.

NOVICE HORSE OPEN & NON PRO: Restricted to horses that have not earned more than \$5000 in lifetime Category 1 NRHA earnings at the start of the NRHA year. Points based on the horse. Novice Horse Non Pro is limited to Non Pro riders.

YOUTH 13 & UNDER: Any Youth 13 & under as of January 1. No stallions will be permitted in any youth class. Ownership of horse is not required. Points based on each horse/rider combination.

YOUTH 14-18: Any Youth 14-18 years of age as of January 1. No stallions will be permitted in any youth class. Ownership of horse is not required. Points based on each horse/ rider combination.

ROOKIE: Open to any rider holding current Non Pro or Amateur card (see description under NON PRO), who has not earned in excess of \$200 lifetime NRHA or ORHA earnings or has not earned more than 50 Youth points at the start of the NRHA year. Ownership of horse is not required. Points based on each horse/rider combination.

GREEN RIDER: Any rider in their 1st calendar year (defined as January 1-December 31) of showing in reining. Points based on each horse/rider combination.

GREEN HORSE: Any horse in their 1st calendar year (defined as January 1-December 31) of showing in reining. Points based on the horse.

MARES: Any age mare. Points based on the horse.

STALLIONS & GELDINGS: Any age stallion or gelding. Points based on the horse.

NRHA Class Guidelines

Open – Any rider.

Intermediate Open – Any rider who has earned less than \$25,000 in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 over the last 3 calendar years.

Limited Open – Any rider who has earned less than \$10,000 lifetime in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 at 1/1/09.

Novice Horse Level 1 – Any rider, but restricted to horses who have not earned more than \$5,000 in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9.

Snaffle Bit/Hackamore 5 & Under Open – Any rider; limited to horses 5 years old or younger, to be shown in a smooth snaffle bit with a broken mouthpiece, or a flexible, braided rawhide, leather, or rope bosal – equipment must comply with NRHA rules.

Non Pro – Open to riders holding a valid NRHA Non Pro card.

Intermediate Non Pro – A Non Pro who has earned less than \$15,000 in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 over the last 3 calendar years.

Limited Non Pro – A Non Pro who has earned less than \$4,500 in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 over the last 3 calendar years.

Prime Time Non Pro – Non Pro riders who are 50yrs and older as of 1/1/09.

Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 – Non Pro rider and restricted to horses who have not earned more than \$5,000 in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9.

Rookie Level 1 – Non Pro riders who have earned less than \$200 lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 or 50 youth points.

Rookie Level 2 – Non Pro riders who have earned less than \$500 lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, and 9 or 100 youth points.

13 & Under and 14-18 – Based on the riders age as of January 1st of the calendar year. Horse must be owned by youth, member of immediate family or as outlined in the NRHA rulebook. No stallions.

Youth Rookie – Open to youth who have less than 25 points in NRHA competition. Horse may be owned by anyone. No stallions.

10 & Under Short Stirrup Class – Open to NRHA members 10 & Under as of 1/1/09. Horse may be owned by any NRHA member. There will be no penalty for holding the saddle with either hand. The rider may ride with standard reins, or with any type of closed reins.

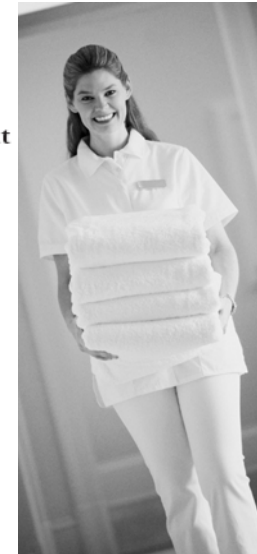
