



COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

The NRHA recommends show management take all necessary precautions to protect their teams, facility personnel, and exhibitors. The health & safety of the performance horse community is the top priority for the Oregon Reining Horse Association.

Exhibitors should not attend the ORHA Reining In Oregon #1 if they have been in contact with anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have a fever or other symptoms or are immunocompromised.

The ORHA Reining Classic is closed to the general public and is held at a privately owned facility. We ask that all exhibitors follow current Oregon guidelines in place with regards to COVID-19 related social distancing & face coverings. We also ask that you respect the policies put in place at the ORHA Reining In Oregon #1 by the Oregon Horse Center & Oregon Reining Horse Association to ensure the health & safety of our exhibitors, show staff & facility staff.

Please be aware:

- Results & Judge's scoresheets will be posted online only
- Draws will be posted online & in designated locations on the grounds
- Show office capacity is limited to one person at a time

We also ask that you do not crowd the gate person, announcer, or show secretary.
